



Please do not purchase this product unless you either have the full confidence to install this product yourself or are prepared to have a professional do it.



Step 1: Front Stock Fender Bracket Installation

- A. If the modified fender is not installed, Install the fender
- B. Using the provided bolts install the fender bracket using a 9/16" socket and wrench.
- C. Mark the fender for the marker light location in preparation for drilling.
- D. Remove the fender bracket.











Step 1: Front Stock Fender Bracket Installation

- E. Using a step bit drill out the marked location to 3/4".
- F. Using the provided bolts install the fender bracket using a 9/16" socket and wrench.
- G. Strip and crimp the end of the wires with the provided butt connector.








Step 2: Marker Light Installation

- H. Install the provided marker light into the back of the fender bracket by removing the rubber grommet then Install the rubber grommet into the predrilled hole in the stock fender.
- I. Install the marker light into the rubber grommet.
- J. Insert the running light through the square hole on the top of the fender bracket.
- K. Using a T20 torx wrench install the running light to the fender.











Step 3: Wiring Harness Installation

L. Reconnect the wiring harness and zip tie the harness up and out of the way.

Note: You may reinstall the stock fender wells with modifications.
